Show Rules and Regulations

Entries:

All entries must be received **no later than May 9, 2010** Send to: **Spring Brook Stables ,46934 Homestead Rd, Steeves Mountain, NB. E1G 4P1**The show committee reserves the right to refuse any entry. **No faxes or emails accepted.**

Late Entries:

Any entries that will be accepted after the closing date of May 9, 2010 **will be subjected to a late fee of \$20.00** per show day. A \$30 fee will be added to any entry with NSF charges.

Incomplete Entries:

Any entry received by the show committee that does not include; Photocopies of Equine Flu/Rhino vaccinations, NBEA or NSEF, completed entry form and signed waiver, *will be subjected to an incomplete entry fee of \$20.00.*

Refunds:

After closing date, refunds of 50% of entry fees (not including administration fee and stabling fee) will be awarded with veterinarian's certificate. Stabling fee will be 100% refundable if stall is filled. There are no refunds after the start of the competition. Substitutions will be allowed.

Ring Size:

All tests will be ridden in a 20m x 60m sand ring.

Ring Numbers:

It is compulsory for the horse's competition number to be worn by the horse or rider/handler anywhere outside the stall from the time that the number is issued until the end of the competition so that officials can identify the horse.

Tests and Divisions:

The following classes will be offered for the day of the competition and will be divided into 3 divisions (Open, Amateur and Junior).. A horse/rider combination may compete in only two consecutive levels and a maximum of four tests per day, including freestyle.

Classes Offered: (\$25.00 per test)

1. Walk/Trot Test A and B
2. Training Level test 1, 2, 3 and 4
3. First level Test 1, 2, 3 and 4
4. Second Level Test 1, 2, 3 and 4
5. Third Level Test 1, 2 and 3
6. Fourth Level Test 1, 2 and 3
8. Freestyle (First through Advanced Level)

Freestyle:

Your music must be on a cd and it is recommended that you ensure it works prior to your freestyle test. Please see dressage canada's website for the freestyle required movements for your level.

Awards:

A special award will be presented for each division (Training through FEI Level). This will be awarded to the horse and rider combination that receives the highest average score over 2 tests at the same level. If a division has only one horse and rider combination, the show committee can choose to combine consecutive levels for this award (example: Third/Fourth Level). Freestyle scores cannot count towards any of the above award. There will also be an overall Freestyle Champion that will be determined by the single highest percentage score.

Awards Ceremony:

Ribbons and awards for all classes will be awarded from 1st place to 5th place. The award presentation will take place 30 minutes after the last ride of the day.

All competitors are required to be in full riding attire with their horses bridled for this presentation.

Memberships:

All competitors and owners are **required** to have the following memberships:
NBEA or NSEF

incomplete entry fee of \$20.00. Competitors in classes restricted by age and/or amateur status must be able to provide proof of eligibility.

Vaccinations:

All horses attending the competition will need to show proof of Equine Flu, strangles and Rhino vaccinations.

It is mandatory to attach photocopies with the entry form; otherwise entry will be subjected to an **incomplete entry fee of \$20.00.**

Stabling:

Stabling is available by reservation only and must be paid in advance. Stabling fees will be \$35weekend for a for a box stall. Stabling will only be available after 12pm on Friday, May 28th. Competitors will be asked to provide their own water buckets and hay. Please note that if you have a preference for stabling arrangements, please make a note on your entry form.
